

JIGYASA PROGRAMME

- Visits of Scientist to schools – lectures/demonstrations by them on topics mapped with the curriculum
- School apprenticeship programme for selected students at the labs
- Helping the students in activities such as Science Exhibitions, Science Congress etc.
- Conduct of teachers workshop
- Scientist as Teachers and Teachers as Scientist Programme.
- Special Summer vacation programmes for students

The students and teachers of Kendriya Vidyalaya are to be engaged in the above activities to achieve objectives of the programme.

This programme is meant to trigger curiosity and research in field of science KVS is collaborating with CSIR for connecting 37 Central Labs with Kendriya Vidyalaya.
